

Bottle Vase Table Centrepiece

Having friends or family over for dinner but your dining room table is looking a bit dull?

In that case, here is a Bottle Vase, which is easy to build, and once finished will certainly spruce up your dining room table.

Note: Adjust the height of the box and the size holes in the top according to the bottles you are using.

- 1 Cut two pieces measuring 144mm x 220mm for the sides.

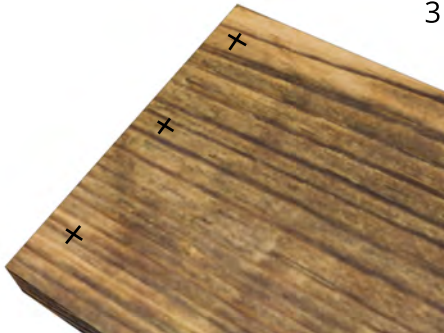


- 2 Cut two pieces measuring 600mm x 144mm for the top and bottom.



- 3 Use 3.5mm x 40mm Eureka Cut screws to construct the box.

Position one screw in the centre and one 20mm in from each side.



- 4 Assemble the box as illustrated here.



- 5 From one side, measure and make marks at 114.5mm, 207mm, 299.5mm, 392mm, and 484.5mm.
Drill 25mm holes at each marks with a Eureka 25mm Spade drill bit.



- 6 Insert the clean glass bottles in the holes in the top.

Lastly, add your favourite flower and place on the table.
