Industrial shelf with THREADED ROD



1. All you need to make this shelf is four 1m lengths of 10mm Eureka Threaded rod, 10mm Eureka nuts and washers.

The three pieces of wood are 220mm x 600mm PAR Pine.



2. Measure 30mm in from each side to determine where to drill the holes for the threaded rod.



3. Use a 10mm Eureka Wood bit to drill holes at the four marks in all three of the planks.

These holes are where the threaded rod will be pushed through.
